

Electrophysiology fellowship:

Division of Cardiology, Stellenbosch University and Tygerberg Hospital

SUNHEART, a centre of the Division of Cardiology, will offer a three-year fellowship for qualified Cardiologists to complete an electrophysiology fellowship at the Division of Cardiology, Department of Medicine, Stellenbosch University and Tygerberg Hospital. The fellowship will be available from 1 September 2024. This training program will be cross platform with the majority of time spent at Tygerberg Hospital and Christian Barnard Memorial Hospital. The division will endeavour to also provide a 3–6-month training period in a high-volume centre abroad.

Requirements

1. Qualification as a Specialist Cardiologist obtained in a recognised training institution – Cert Cardio (Phys) or equivalent;
2. Registration with the HPCSA as a Specialist Cardiologist (candidates in the process of registration will also be considered)

Candidates who are currently sitting for their examinations are encouraged to apply as they may be appointed on condition that they obtain the relevant qualifications.

Recommendations

1. MPhil (Cardiology)
2. Previous experience in electrophysiology
3. Previous experience in heart failure interventions
4. Previous research experience

Duties

1. Participating fully in all activities of the division - program available on request
2. Logbook of all cases to be kept
3. EHRA and CASSA accreditation at completion of fellowship
